PAYMENT: A full deposit of \$250 per person is required. Final payment for trip, including optional insurance premium if applicable, is due 90 days prior to departure. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$30 will be assessed.

SAVINGS: Early registration discounts (not available to Hosts/Co-Hosts) are deducted from the balance of your bill after deposit.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While EOT will try to match roommates, EOT cannot guarantee a roommate will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$295 during the basic tour.

ITINERARY CHANGES: If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$90 per night; single rooms \$110 per night. Meals for extra nights are not included.

AIRLINE TICKETS: In order to keep prices low, EOT does not guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. Once printed, airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES: All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. EOT is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making own flight arrangements to departure city, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties.

CANCELLATION FEES: 100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Insurance Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. ...Explore Your Biblical Roots

Day 1: USA / Tel Aviv

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart on your overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Meals and refreshments will be served aloft.

Day 2: Arrive Tel Aviv Airport / Jerusalem

After arrival in **Tel Aviv**, you will be met by an Educational Opportunities representative who will be with you during your stay in the Holy Land. Transfer to your hotel in Jerusalem. **(Dinner)**

Day 3: Tiberias

Today will be spent visiting the sights around the **Sea of Galilee**. We will begin the day by visiting the **Church of the Beatitudes**, the traditional site of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. Enjoy time for meditation and prayer in the tranquil site with its breathtaking view of the Sea of Galilee. Walk down the hill to **Tabgha**, the traditional place of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. Visit **Capernaum**, the center of Jesus' ministry in Galilee for three years. Visit the excavations and the remains of the ancient synagogue where Jesus preached and see the house of Peter's mother-in-law. Take a most memorable boat ride across the Sea of Galilee.

This afternoon drive to **Cana of Galilee**, where Our Lord performed His first miracle - changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Then drive to the **Summit of Mount Tabor** to visit the site of the Transfiguration of Jesus. Return to Jerusalem. **(Breakfast and Dinner)**

Day 4: Jerusalem

This morning, drive to the top of the **Mount of Olives** for a spectacular view of Jerusalem. Visit the **Church of Pater Noster** (commemorating the "Our Father"), the **Chapel of Ascension** (commemorating the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven), the **Russian Ascension Church** where you will see **Armenian Mosaics** from the Byzantine period. Proceed to the **Chapel of Dominus Flevit**, where Jesus wept over Jerusalem and foretold its complete destruction. On to the **Garden of Gethsemane** and the **Church of All Nations** which commemorates the Agony in the Garden. Visit the **Church of the Virgin Mary** and the **Tomb of Our Lady** where the Virgin Mary is believed to have laid before her Assumption. Drive to visit the **Armenian Convent of Polyucte** and peek at the **Mosaic of Birds**. This brilliantly colored and delicate mosaic floor is thought to be one of the first monuments to the unknown soldier; beneath it is a grave containing the bones of Armenian warriors. Attend the **Holy Thursday service of Votunluva** ("Washing of the Feet") and *Khavaroom* at **St. James Cathedral**. **(Breakfast and Dinner)**

Day 5: Jerusalem

This morning, drive to **Bethlehem**. Above the traditional **Grotto of Jesus' birth**, visit the **Nativity Church**. Tour the **Manger**. Behold the fourteen-pointed star that bears the inscription: Here Jesus Christ was born to the Virgin Mary. Of the fifteen lamps burning around the recess, five belong to the Armenians. See the two altars that belong to the Armenians, one dedicated to the **Blessed Virgin** and the

other known as the **Altar of the Kings**. Visit the **Armenian Monastery**, most of which dates from the Byzantine and Crusader periods; once a major center for Armenian hermits and later full of seventeenth-century scribes copying and illustrating Bibles. The roof of the monastery offers a unique panoramic view of Bethlehem and its terraced environs. The water of the well facing the arched entrance is believed by pilgrims to have curative properties. The Armenians of Jerusalem celebrate Christmas every year on January 19, according to the Julian calendar. Return to **Jerusalem** for the evening **Good Friday Burial Service at St. James Cathedral**. **(Breakfast and Dinner)**

Day 6: Jerusalem

Enter into the **Old City** through **St. Stephen's Gate**. View the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus cured the paralytic who had been ill for thirty-eight years and visit the **Church of St. Anne**. Follow the **Via Dolorosa** (*Way of the Cross*) to visit **Lithostrotos**, **Flagellation** and **Ecce Homo**. Proceed through the exotic **Arab bazaar** and winding cobble stoned streets to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, the most venerated shrine in Christendom, and the center of Christian worship in Jerusalem. See the **stone of Unction**, **Golgotha**, the **Armenian Gallery** (*Vernadoon*), the domed twelfth-century **Armenian Chapel of Helena**, which is one of the most attractive places in the church, its rock walls covered with crosses scratched by medieval pilgrims. From here thirteen narrow steps lead down into the **Crypt of the Finding of the Cross** itself. Finally,

pay special homage to **Calvary** and the Tomb of Our Lord Jesus. Attend the **Holy Saturday service of the Light Ceremony**. **(Breakfast and Dinner)**.

Day 7: Jerusalem

Sunday Service at St. James Cathedral celebrates **Armenian Easter in Jerusalem**. Enter the **St. James Monastery** through the main gate. Once inside the monastery, it is a must to visit **St. James Cathedral** and the chapels inside: the chapel of **St. James**, the chapel of **Holy Etchmiadzin**, the chapel of **St. Menas** and the chapel/vestry of **St. Stepanos**. Other interesting sites within the walls of the monastery include: the **patriarchal quarters**, the **library**, the **manuscript repository** in the **chapel of St. Toros**, the **old printing quarter**, the **monks' quarters**, the **museum**, **St. Tarkmanchats Armenian daily school** and the living quarters of lay residents. Attached to St. James Monastery are **St. Hreshtakapetats** [*Holy Archangels*] **Monastery** and the old living quarters of Armenian nuns. Outside the walls of the Old City, but only a short distance from St. James Monastery, is **St. Prkich** [*Holy Savior*] **Monastery**, which is where the Armenian cemetery is

located. Beyond the walls of St. James Monastery lies the **Armenian quarter**, where local Armenians still reside.

Day 8: Full day Dead Sea and Jericho

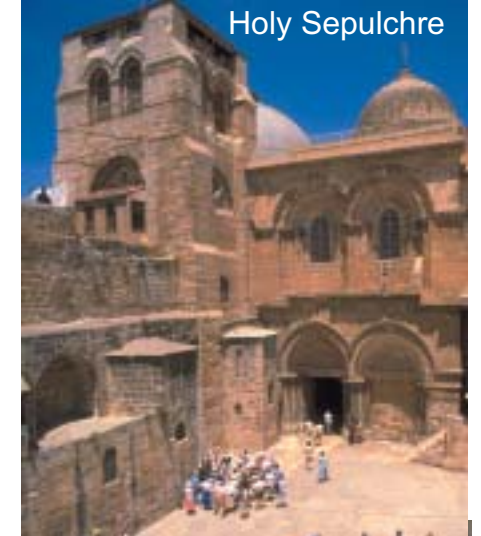
Depart Jerusalem for the **Jordan Valley**: Drive along the Judean Wilderness to **Bethany**, where Our Lord would come to recuperate in the home of His loving friends, Mary, Martha, and Lazarus, before setting out once more on His arduous task. Visit the **Tomb of Lazarus** and proceed to view the **Good Samaritan Inn**. Continue through the Judean Wilderness to view the **Dead Sea**; on to ancient Jericho, the oldest known city in the Western world. From the top of the ancient "*tel*", you'll have an excellent view of **Elisha's Fountain**, the **Qarantal**, and the **Mount of Temptation**. Drive along the shores of the **Dead Sea** to reach the Archeological excavations of **Qumran**, here the Dead Sea Scrolls were found by a wandering shepherd. **(Breakfast and Dinner)**

Day 9: Depart to the U.S.A
